Applicants must meet the following requirements:

Eligibility: An applicant must be African-American or of African descent and transferring to an accredited four-year college or university in the fall of 2018; must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5.

Application: An applicant must submit a **typewritten** application accompanied by **an official transcript as well as an essay**. The essay (two, double spaced, typewritten pages) should state your educational goals and career aspirations and any information expressing financial need. Also, please express your feelings about at least one “critical issue” (economics, education, etc.) affecting the status of the African American community and how that issue should be addressed.

Deadline: Applicant must return all material no later than **May 25, 2018**. Applications postmarked after May 25, 2018 will not be considered.

Selection Procedure: The Education/Scholarship Committee will review each application and a winner will be notified by June 9, 2018.

Awards: Each recipient will be required to submit proof of full time enrollment for the fall of 2018 semester/quarter at a four year institution. Proof of enrollment qualifies as a letter or course print-out from the university’s registrars office. Scholarship checks will not be issued until proof of enrollment is received.
