Application: An applicant must submit a **typewritten** application accompanied by **an official transcript as well as an essay**. Your essay must be a maximum of three (3) double-spaced, typewritten pages stating educational goals, career aspirations and any information expressing financial need. Additionally 1-2 letters of recommendation is required.

Deadline: Applicant must return all material no later than **June 1, 2019**. Applications postmarked after June 1, 2019 will not be considered.

Selection Procedure: The Education/Scholarship Committee will review each application and a winner will be notified by June 30, 2019.

Awards: Each recipient will be required to submit proof of full time enrollment for the fall of 2019 semester/quarter at a graduate program. Proof of enrollment qualifies as a letter or course print-out from the university's registrar's office. Scholarship checks will not be issued until proof of enrollment is received.
